F.A.Q.s

- **The Statement of Economic Interest Sheet must be filed in the calendar year 2016 and must be filed for purposes of being a Candidate for the office you are seeking ie: Candidate for Alderman Ward 1. If you have already filed a Statement of Economic Interest Sheet for any other purpose in 2016, including for the Office you currently hold, you must file again as a Candidate.**
- Candidates may file their petitions without their Receipt for Filing their Statement of Economic Interest, provided that the Receipt for Filing their Statement of Economic Interest is submitted to the Clerk by the last day of filing **(12/19/2016 by 5:00 p.m.)**.
- A candidate may choose to have someone else file their petition on their behalf.
- A candidate may file their own petitions and those of another candidate at the same time.
- A candidate may file for more than one office at the same time, provided they withdraw all but one (1) within five (5) days after the last day of filing.
- Lottery for First and Last Ballot Placement will take place at 10:00 a.m., Tuesday, December 20, 2016 for those who filed simultaneously at the Administration Office in City Hall.
- Petitions for Candidacy received in the first round of mail on Monday, December 12, 2016 will be considered as being filed during the 8:30 a.m. simultaneous filing.

## D-5 NOTICE OF OBLIGATION

TO: All Candidates for Nomination, Election or Retention to Public Office and for Questions of Public Policy

This letter is to officially notify you of your filing obligation under Article 9 of the Election Code (An Act to Regulate Campaign Financing).

**ALL CAMPAIGN DISCLOSURE DOCUMENTS, INCLUDING THE D-1 STATEMENT OF ORGANIZATION, MUST BE FILED WITH THE STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS ONLY.**

**The Act requires a political committee to file a form D-1, Statement of Organization, within 10 business days of the creation of such committee, except any political committee created within the 30 days before an election must file a Statement of Organization within 2 business days. Required forms and A Guide to Campaign Disclosure are available from the Board offices and online. Failure to file or late filing of a Statement of Organization will result in a civil penalty being imposed by the Board.**

Committees who must file fall within five categories: Candidate Political Committee, Political Party Committee, Political Action Committee, Ballot Initiative Committee, or Independent Expenditure Committee.

### 10 ILCS 5/9-1.8 Political Committees

**Candidate Political Committee:** means the candidate himself or herself or any natural person, trust, partnership, corporation, or other organization or group of persons designated by the candidate that accepts contributions or makes expenditures during any 12 month period in an aggregate amount exceeding \$5000 on behalf of the candidate.

**Political Party Committee:** means the State central committee of a political party, a county central committee of a political party, a legislative caucus committee, or a committee formed by a ward or township committeeman of a political party. A legislative caucus committee means a committee established for the purpose of electing candidates to the General Assembly by the person elected President of the Senate, Minority Leader of the Senate, Speaker of the House of Representatives, Minority Leader of the House of Representatives, or a committee established by 5 or more members of the same caucus of the Senate or 10 or more members of the same caucus of the House of Representatives.

**Political Action Committee:** means any natural person, trust, partnership, committee, association corporation, or other organization or group of persons, other than a candidate, political party, candidate political committee, or political party committee, that accepts contributions or makes expenditures during any 12 month period in an aggregate of amount exceeding \$5000 on behalf of or in opposition to a candidate or candidates for political office. Political Action Committee includes any natural person, trust, partnership, committee, association, corporation, or other organization or group of persons, other than a candidate, political party, candidate political committee, or political party committee, that makes electioneering communications during any 12 month period in an aggregate amount exceeding \$5000 related to any candidate or candidates for public office.

**Ballot Initiative Committee:** means any natural person, trust, partnership, committee, association, corporation, or other organization or group of persons that accepts contributions or makes expenditures during any 12 month period in an aggregate amount exceeding \$5000 in support of or in opposition to any question of public policy to be submitted to the electors. Ballot initiative committee includes any natural person, trust, partnership, committee, association, corporation, or other organization or group of persons that makes electioneering communications during any 12 month period in an aggregate amount exceeding \$5000 related to any question of public policy to be submitted to the voters. The \$5000 threshold applies to any contributions or expenditures received or made with the purpose of securing a place on the ballot for, advocating the defeat or passage of, or engaging in electioneering communication regarding the question of public policy, regardless of the method of initiation of the question of public policy and regardless of whether petitions have been circulated or filed with the appropriate office or whether the question has been adopted and certified by the governing body.

**Independent Expenditure Committee:** means any trust, partnership, committee, association, corporation, or other organization or group of persons formed for the exclusive purpose of making independent expenditures during any 12-month period in an aggregate amount exceeding \$5000 in support of or in opposition to (i) the nomination for election, election, retention, or defeat of any public official or candidate or (ii) any question of public policy to be submitted to the electors. "Independent expenditure committee" also includes any trust, partnership, committee, association, corporation, or other organization or group of persons that makes electioneering communications that are not made in connection, consultation, or concert with or at the request or suggestion of a public official or candidate, a public official's or candidate's designated political committee or campaign, or an agent or agents of the public official, candidate, or political committee or campaign during any 12-month period in an aggregate amount exceeding \$5000 related to (i) the nomination for election, election, retention, or defeat of any public official or candidate or (ii) any question of public policy to be submitted to the voters.

## COUNCIL-MANAGER FORM OF GOVERNMENT - MUNICIPAL

Upon adoption of the managerial form of government, the procedures for electing municipal officers will remain the same as prior to the adoption of 65 ILCS, Article 5. A referendum may be approved by the voters to establish a different type of municipal organization in conjunction with the managerial form.

The council-manager form is the only form of municipal government covered (for election of officers) by Article 5 of 65 ILCS/5. Other cities and villages which have adopted Article 5 and have retained or later adopted the mayor-aldermanic form or the president-trustee village form will follow the provisions under Article 3.1 of 65 ILCS/5 for the election of officers. Cities and villages which have adopted or retained a commission form would follow provisions under Article 4 of 65 ILCS/5 for the election of officers.

Refer to the appropriate section of this guide for either mayor-aldermanic, president-trustee or commission form if the municipality is also a managerial form.

OFFICE: Mayor, Councilmen at-large (and part from districts in some cities), Clerk, Treasurer

QUALIFICATIONS: Qualified elector/registered voter.

A person is not eligible to take the oath of office for a municipal office if that person is, at the time required for taking the oath of office, in arrears in the payment of a tax or other indebtedness due to the municipality or has been convicted in any court located in the United States of any infamous crime, bribery, perjury, or other felony. [65 ILCS 5/3.1-10-5(a)(b)]

RESIDENCY: One-year residency in the municipality preceding the election. If a person is a resident of a municipality immediately prior to the active duty military service of that person or that person's spouse, resides anywhere outside of the municipality during that active duty military service, and immediately upon completion of that active duty military service is again a resident of the municipality, then the time during which the person resides outside the municipality during the active duty military service is deemed to be time during which the person is a resident of the municipality for purposes of determining the residency requirement. [65 ILCS 5/3.1-10-5]

SIGNATURE REQUIREMENTS: Cities and villages that retained or later adopted Article 3.1 of 65 ILCS, see Mayor-Alderman and President-Trustee form for signature requirements.

If a city has adopted the nonpartisan form of government as authorized by Article VII of the Constitution, the signature requirements which applies would be those in 10 ILCS 5/10-3 of the Election Code (independent signature requirements) as authorized by the second paragraph of [10 ILCS 5/10-3.1.] (See page 25)

**MAYOR-ALDERMAN AND PRESIDENT-TRUSTEE FORM  
MUNICIPAL**

**NOTE:** Candidates of established political parties file petitions to be placed on the Consolidated Primary Election ballot in municipalities of over 5,000 population.

Municipalities of 5,000 or less population may determine by ordinance, no later than November 15, 2016, that political parties shall nominate candidates for municipal offices by primary election in accordance with Article 7 of the Election Code.

[10 ILCS 5/7-1(b)]

**OFFICE:** Mayor or President, Alderman or Trustee, Clerk, Treasurer

Cities of 10,000 or fewer inhabitants may, by ordinance, allow for the appointment of a city treasurer. [65 ILCS 5/3.1-15-5]

Villages of fewer than 5,000 inhabitants may, by resolution, choose to have the clerk appointed by the village president with the concurrence of the village board. .  
[65 ILCS 5/3.1-25-90(a)]

This procedure for election of officers includes municipalities which have adopted the managerial form and retained or later adopted the mayor-aldermanic or president-trustee form of electing their officers.  
[65 ILCS 5/5-1-2]

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Qualified elector/registered voter.

A person is not eligible to take the oath of office for a municipal office if that person is, at the time required for taking the oath of office, in arrears in the payment of a tax or other indebtedness due to the municipality or has been convicted in any court located in the United States of any infamous crime, bribery, perjury, or other felony. [65 ILCS 5/3.1-10-5(a)(b)]

**RESIDENCY:** Mayor or President, Clerk, Treasurer and Trustee: One-year residency in the municipality preceding the Consolidated Election. If a person is a resident of a municipality immediately prior to the active duty military service of that person or that person's spouse, resides anywhere outside of the municipality during that active duty military service, and immediately upon completion of that active duty military service is again a resident of the municipality, then the time during which the person resides outside the municipality during the active duty military service is deemed to be time during which the person is a resident of the municipality for purposes of determining the residency requirement.

[65 ILCS 5/3.1-10-5(a)(d)]

Alderman must reside in the ward at least 1 year preceding their election. Trustees elected from districts must reside in their municipality at least 1 year preceding their election. Trustees elected by district in villages with a population of over 5,000, each of the districts shall be represented by one trustee who shall have been a resident of the district for at least six months immediately before his or her election in the first election after redistricting. [65 ILCS 3.1-10-5(c), 3.1-25-75(a)(b)]

For president, mayor, trustee or clerk, at least .5% (.005) of the qualified **primary** electors of his or her **party** in the city, incorporated town, town or village. [10 ILCS 5/7-10(e)]

For alderman, at least .5% (.005) of the qualified primary electors of this or her **party** within his/her ward. [10 ILCS 5/7-10(e)]

In no event shall the number of required signatures be less than 25. [10 ILCS 5/7-10(e)]

The number of qualified primary electors is determined by taking the total vote cast for the candidate for such political party who received the highest number of votes in such political subdivision, ward or district at the last regular election at which an officer was regularly scheduled to be elected from that subdivision, ward or district. [10 ILCS 5/7-10]

In the case of an election for alderman or trustee of a municipality to be elected from a ward or district, for the first primary following a redistricting or the initial establishment of wards or districts, then by .5% of the total number of votes cast for the candidate of such political party who received the highest number of votes in the entire municipality at the last regular election which an officer was regularly scheduled to be elected from the entire municipality, divided by the number of wards or districts, but in any event not less than 25 qualified primary electors of his party in the ward or district. [10 ILCS 5/7-10(e)]

**New Political Party Candidates - For the Consolidated Election, not less than 5% of the total number of persons who voted in the last regular election in the district or political subdivision in which such district or political subdivision voted as a unit for the election of officers to serve its respective territorial area. [10 ILCS 5/10-2]**

For the first election following redistricting of municipal wards or districts, or for the first election following the initial establishment of such districts or wards in a municipality, a petition to form a new political party in a municipal ward or district shall be signed by qualified voters of the district or ward equal to not less than 5% of the total number of votes cast at the preceding municipal election, as the

case may be, for the municipal office voted on throughout the municipality for which the greatest total number of votes were cast for all candidates, divided by the number of districts or wards, but in any event not less than 25 qualified voters of the district or ward. In the case of a petition to form a new political party within a political subdivision in which officers are to be elected from districts and at-large, such petition shall consist of separate components for each district from which an officer is to be elected. [10 ILCS 5/10-2]

**Independent Candidates** - For the Consolidated Election, not less than 5% nor more than 8% (or 50 more than the minimum, whichever is greater) of the number of persons who voted at the last regular election in the district or political subdivision in which such district or political subdivision voted as a unit for the election of officers to serve its respective territorial area. [10 ILCS 5/10-3]

**Example:** If 1,000 voters cast ballots at the last regular election in the district or political subdivision, the formula of 5% - 8% would result in a signature requirement of 50 - 80. Illinois statutes [10 ILCS 5/10-3] require a difference of 50 between the minimum and maximum. Therefore, the signature requirement would be 50 - 100.

For the first election following redistricting of municipal wards or districts, or for the first election following the initial establishment of such districts or wards in a municipality, nomination papers for an independent candidate for alderman or trustee of such municipality, shall be signed by qualified voters of the district or ward equal to not less than 5% nor more than 8% (or 50 more than the minimum, whichever is greater) of the total number of votes cast at the preceding general municipal election, as the case may be, for the municipal office voted on throughout such county or municipality for which the greatest total number of votes were cast for all candidates divided by the number of districts or wards, but in any event not less than 25 qualified voters of the district or ward. [10 ILCS 5/10-3]

## 2.01 - Ward boundaries.

The number of wards of the City and the boundaries hereof are hereby established as follows:

First Ward. That part of the City of Elmhurst described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the western boundary of the City (being the centerline of Villa Avenue) with the centerline of the right-of-way of the Union Pacific Railway for a place of beginning; running thence easterly along the centerline of the said railway right-of-way to the intersection of said railway right-of-way with the centerline of Oak Street; thence northerly along the centerline of Oak Street to its intersection with the centerline of North Avenue (Illinois Route 64); thence easterly along the centerline of North Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of York Street; thence southerly along the centerline of York Street to its intersection with the centerline of St. Charles Road; thence westerly along the centerline of St. Charles Road to the western boundary of the City (being the centerline of Villa Avenue); thence northerly along the centerline of Villa Avenue to the place of beginning.

Second Ward. That part of the City of Elmhurst described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the westerly boundary of the City (being the centerline of Illinois Route 83) with the northerly boundary of the City (being the northerly right-of-way line of Old Grand Avenue) for a place of beginning; running thence easterly along said boundary to its intersection with the centerline of Larch Avenue extended northerly; thence southerly along the centerline of Larch Avenue extended northerly and the centerline of Larch Avenue to the centerline of Crockett Avenue extended easterly; thence westerly along the centerline of Crockett Avenue extended easterly and the centerline of Crockett Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Walnut Avenue; thence southerly along the centerline of Walnut Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Armitage Avenue; thence easterly along the centerline of Armitage Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Lake Street (U.S. Route 20); thence southeasterly along the centerline of Lake Street to its intersection with the centerline of York Street; thence southerly along the centerline of York Street to its intersection with the centerline of North Avenue (Illinois Route 64); thence westerly along the centerline of North Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Oak Street; thence southerly along the centerline of Oak Street to the centerline of the right-of-way of the Union Pacific Railway; thence westerly along the centerline of said railway right-of-way to the western boundary of the City, being the centerline of Salt Creek; thence generally northerly along the centerline of Salt Creek to its intersection with the north right-of-way line of Sidney Avenue extended westerly; thence easterly along said right-of-way line to its intersection with the west right-of-way line of Illinois Route 83; thence northerly along the west right-of-way line of Illinois Route 83 to the north right-of-way line of Fay Avenue extended westerly; thence easterly along said north right-of-way line of Fay Avenue to the centerline of Illinois Route 83; thence northerly along the centerline of Illinois Route 83 to the place of beginning.

Third Ward. That part of the City of Elmhurst described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the northerly boundary of the City (being the north right-of-way line of Grand Avenue) with the centerline of Larch Avenue extended northerly for a place of beginning; thence southerly along the centerline of Larch Avenue extended northerly and the centerline of Larch Avenue to the centerline of Crockett Avenue extended easterly; thence westerly along the centerline of Crockett Avenue extended easterly and the centerline of Crockett Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Walnut Avenue; thence southerly along the centerline of Walnut Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Armitage Avenue; thence easterly along the centerline of Armitage Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Lake Street (U.S. Route 20); thence southeasterly along the centerline of Lake Street to its intersection with the centerline of York Street; thence southerly along the centerline of York Street to its intersection with the centerline of Third Street; thence easterly along the centerline of Third Street to the centerline of Geneva Avenue; thence northerly along the centerline of Geneva Avenue to the centerline of North Avenue (Illinois Route 64); thence easterly along the centerline of North Avenue to the easterly boundary of the City; thence generally northerly along said easterly boundary (being the east right-of-way line of County Line Road) to the north right-of-way line of Grand Avenue; thence westerly along said north right-of-way line of Grand Avenue to its intersection with the westerly boundary of Mt. Emblem Cemetery extended northerly; thence southerly along said cemetery boundary to its intersection with the

northerly boundary of the City; thence generally westerly along the boundary of the City to the north right-of-way line of Grand Avenue (being the northerly boundary of the City); thence westerly along the northerly boundary of the City to the place of beginning; excepting therefrom those portions of unincorporated DuPage County lying west of County Line Road, south of Grand Avenue. East of York Street, and north of Lake Street.

Fourth Ward. That part of the City of Elmhurst described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the centerline of York Street and the centerline of Third Street for a place of beginning; thence easterly along the centerline of Third Street to the centerline of Geneva Avenue; thence northerly along the centerline of Geneva Avenue to the centerline of North Avenue (Illinois Route 64); thence easterly along the centerline of North Avenue to the easterly City boundary (being the easterly boundary of DuPage County); thence southerly along the said easterly boundary to its intersection with the centerline of the Illinois Prairie Path (being the former Chicago and Great Western Railroad right-of-way); thence westerly along the centerline of the Illinois Prairie Path to the centerline of Poplar Avenue; thence northerly along the centerline of Poplar Avenue to the centerline of St. Charles Road; thence westerly along the centerline of St. Charles Road to the centerline of York Street; thence northerly along the centerline of York Street to the place of beginning.

Fifth Ward. That part of the City of Elmhurst described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the centerline of St. Charles Road and the centerline of Poplar Avenue for a place of beginning; thence southerly along the centerline of Poplar Avenue to the centerline of Vallette Street; thence westerly along the centerline of Vallette Street to its intersection with the centerline of York Street; thence southeasterly along the centerline of York Street to its intersection with the centerline of Cayuga Avenue; thence westerly along the centerline of Cayuga Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Euclid Avenue; thence northerly along the centerline of Euclid Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of McKinley Avenue; thence westerly along the centerline of McKinley Avenue and McKinley Avenue extended westerly to its intersection with the west boundary of the City; thence generally west and north along said westerly boundary of the City to that point at which Salt Creek intersects the centerline of St. Charles Road; thence easterly along the centerline of St. Charles Road to the place of beginning.

Sixth Ward. That part of the City of Elmhurst described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the centerline of York Street and the centerline of Vallette Street for a place of beginning; thence easterly along the centerline of Vallette Street to the centerline of Poplar Avenue; thence northerly along the centerline of Poplar Avenue to the centerline of the Illinois Prairie Path (being the former Chicago and Great Western Railroad right-of-way); thence easterly along the centerline of the Illinois Prairie Path to the easterly boundary of the City; thence generally southerly along the easterly boundary of the City to a point where the westerly right-of-way line of Caldwell Avenue intersects the southerly right-of-way line of Lexington Avenue; thence northerly along the westerly right-of-way line of Caldwell Avenue to its intersection with the southerly right-of-way line of Harrison Street; thence generally westerly along the southerly boundary of the City to its intersection with the easterly right-of-way line of York Street; thence generally southeasterly along the boundary of the City of its intersection with the southerly right-of-way line of Roosevelt Road (Illinois Route 38); thence generally westerly along the southerly right-of-way line of Roosevelt Road (being the southerly boundary of the City) to its intersection with the centerline of Euclid Avenue extended southerly; thence northerly along the centerline of Euclid Avenue extended southerly and the centerline of Euclid Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Butterfield Road (Illinois Route 56); thence southwesterly along the centerline of Butterfield Road to its intersection with the centerline of Bryan Street; thence northerly along the centerline of Bryan Street to its intersection with the centerline of McKinley Avenue; thence easterly along the centerline of McKinley Avenue to the centerline of Euclid Avenue; thence southerly along the centerline of Euclid Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Cayuga Avenue; thence easterly along the centerline of Cayuga Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of York Street; thence northwesterly along the centerline of York Street to the place of beginning; excepting therefrom those parts of unincorporated DuPage County lying south of Butterfield Road, east of Euclid Avenue, north of Roosevelt Road, and west of York Street.

Seventh Ward. That part of the City of Elmhurst described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the centerline of McKinley Avenue and the centerline of Bryan Street for a place of beginning; thence southerly along the centerline of Bryan Street to its intersection with the centerline of Butterfield Road (Illinois Route 56); thence northeasterly along the centerline of Butterfield Road to the centerline of Euclid Avenue; thence southerly along the centerline of Euclid Avenue to the northerly right-of-way line of Brush Hill Road (being also the northerly right-of-way line of Roosevelt Road (Illinois Route 38) and being the southerly City boundary); thence generally westerly along the southerly City boundary to the westerly City boundary (being the easterly right-of-way line of Illinois Route 83); thence northerly along the westerly City boundary to its intersection with the centerline of McKinley Avenue extended westerly; thence easterly along the centerline of McKinley Avenue extended westerly and the centerline of McKinley Avenue to the place of beginning; excepting therefrom those parts of unincorporated DuPage County lying south of Butterfield Road, west of Euclid Avenue, north of Roosevelt Road, and east of Prospect Avenue.
