Citizen's Police Academy is a 12-week program designed to give Elmhurst citizens a working knowledge of both their police department and of general law enforcement practices. The program provides participants with a better understanding of some of the challenges faced by police officers in the field, along with insight into how officers might handle different situations and why. Many of the classes offer opportunities for hands-on participation.



Each weekly block of instruction is held from 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. on consecutive Wednesday evenings, beginning this next session on Wednesday, March 1, 2017, and continuing through May 17, 2017. The program is free of charge but is limited to 25 students per session. Participants must be over the age of twenty-one and live or work in the City of Elmhurst.
