Citizen's Police Academy 22nd Session!

The Citizen's Police Academy is a 12-week program designed to give citizens a better understanding of their specific local police department as well as general Law Enforcement topics.

The program is free of charge and is limited to 25 students per session. Participants must be over the age of twenty-one and live or work in the City of Elmhurst.

Classes are held at the Elmhurst Police Department's Training room, located at 125 E. First Street.



One block of instruction is offered each week, beginning Wednesday, March 1st, continuing through Wednesday, May 17th, 2017, from 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m.

Sessions may include instruction on:

- Department Overview & History/Field Training
- Arrest, Search & Seizure Laws
- Internet Investigation/Railroad Safety
- Evidence and Crime Scene Processing
- Investigation/Crime Analysis
- Mission Team/Narcotics & K-9 Unit
- Interviewing and Interrogations
- DUI and Traffic Enforcement
- Fire Department Overview
- Range & Firearms Training
- Emergency Response Team (ERT)/Crisis Negotiation
- Traffic Stops

Participants are able to ask questions, discuss issues, watch demonstrations, and participate in some of the same training drills that our officers complete in order to perform their duties.
