

Sign up now for the next session of the ELMHURST CITIZEN'S POLICE ACADEMY!



Citizen's Police Academy is a 12-week program designed to give Elmhurst residents a behind-the-scenes look at their police department with a general overview of basic law enforcement practices. The program provides participants with a better understanding of challenges faced by police officers in the field along with insight into how certain types of incidents might be resolved. Many of the classes offer opportunities for hands-on participation with actual police equipment and training procedures.



Each weekly block of instruction is held from 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. on consecutive Wednesday evenings. The next session will begin on Wednesday, **August 28** and continue through **November 13, 2019**. The program is free of charge but is limited to 25 students per session. Participants must be over the age of twenty-one and live or work in the city of Elmhurst.
